- The theme for this year's Vacation Bible School is *Great Big Beautiful World*. VBS continues through August 4 between 5:45-8:00 PM each evening. Dinner will be served from 5:15-5:45 PM. Children ages 3 years-completed 5th grade are encouraged to come and bring a friend!
- Youth/children activities for the month of August include: Youth will volunteer at Orphan Grain Train on August 15 from 9:00 AM-12:00 PM and Toddler Time on August 18 for pre-K children at McElroy Park from 6:00-7:30 PM. Must be accompanied by parent.
- During the summer months we will continue our journey through the book of Acts. The Acts of the Apostles is the second of two New Testament books written by Luke.
